DIDIER DAGUENEAU “PUR SANG” POUILLY FUMÉ,
2014, Loire Valley, France 26 / 125

“The wines at Domaine Didier Dagueneau deserve their rightful place among the great “singular” wines of the world. Eric Asimov, in his obituary of the late Didier Dagueaneau in the The New York Times, seemed to sum it up well: “Tasting a Dagueneau wine for the first time was a revelation. His Sauvignon Blancs had an unexpected purity and clarity to them. The flavors were intense but nuanced. It wasn’t the fruit that was piercing, as in so many Sauvignon Blancs, but the freshness and the focus. As powerful a personality as he was, his wines did not exalt the stature of the winemaker so much as the beauty of the terroir.” - Marsella Charron

PETER MICHAEL “MA BELLE-FILLE” CHARDONNAY,
“2014, Knights Valley, Sonoma County, California 40 / 185
The 2014 Chardonnay Ma Belle Fille has essentially the same aromatic and flavor profile as well as huge body and concentration that also characterized the 2015, with oodles of caramelized citrus and honeysuckle in its explosive aromatics and intense flavors. Both are fabulous Chardonnays like their siblings and should be drunk over the next 10-12 years”

ZENA CROWN VINEYARD “SLOPE” PINOT NOIR,
2013, Eola-Amity Hills, Willamette Valley, Oregon 30 / 150
“Rich and expressive, featuring black cherry and pepper notes set against tangy mineral flavors. Comes together smoothly as the finish gains traction, with a light bite of tannins. Drink now through 2023.”

TORBRECK “THE FACTOR” SHIRAZ
2009, Barossa Valley, Australia 55 / 200
“Deep garnet-purple in color, the 2009 The Factor begins with lovely warm blackberry and creme de cassis notes highlighted by mulberries, mincemeat and dusty earth scents. Very big, rich and full, the palate has some dried berry character, a firm level of chewy tannins, balanced acid freshness and a long finish. Drink it from 2014 to 2024+.”
