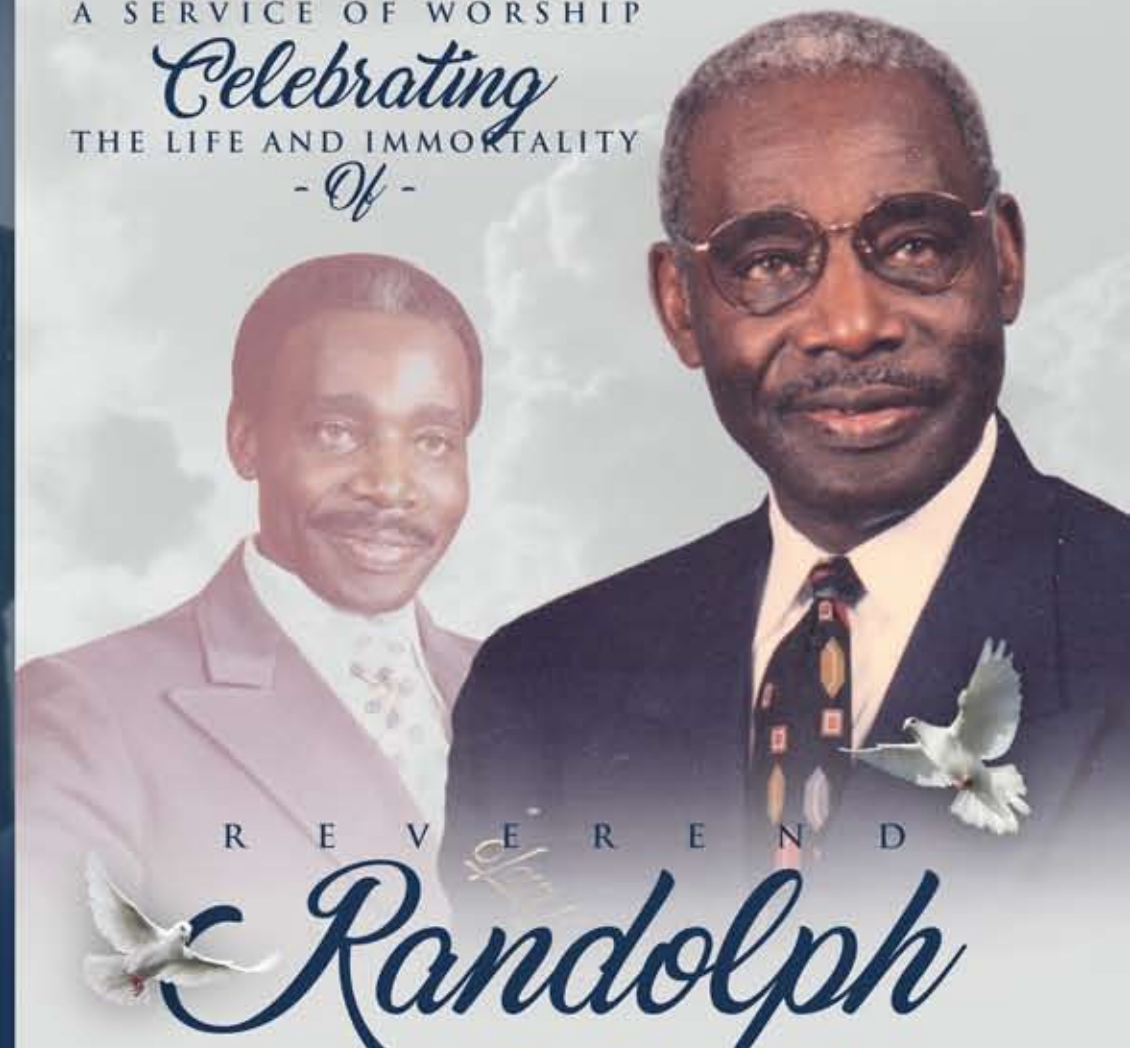

# The Obituary

Rev. Randolph F. Henlon was born on August 5, 1928, in Camaguey, Cuba to the parents of Hebzeba and Hubert Henlon. He has one brother, Selbourne (predeceased) and one sister, Lorenza.

Rev. Randolph F. Henlon obtained his early education at Waldensia All Age School in Sherwood Content, Trelawny, Jamaica. Soon after his parents migrated back to Jamaica Rev. Henlon received his High School Diploma. He continued his education and received a Bachelor of Science from Marygrove College here in Detroit.

Rev. Henlon a divorcee held several jobs as supervisor of Agricultural Farm Programme in Belle Glade, Florida, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, Hartford, Connecticut and Louisiana. The motor car industry was flourishing in Detroit in the early 60's. Rev Henlon along with two other friends migrated to Detroit seeking employment. He first landed night jobs with Chrysler and Ford Motor Company, but could not keep them for long because at both jobs he was caught sleeping. He later turned his attention to a delivery truck driver, real estate salesman, associate pastor, and interim pastor at New Prospect MBC between October 1996 to 1999.

Rev. Henlon's Christian background began at an early age. His grandmother, Elizabeth Johnson, played a pivotal role towards this journey. However, his mentor was Rev. S. Leon Whitney. He adored him extraordinarily as a coach, guidance counselor, friend, and spiritual father.

Rev. Henlon was a true friend to all who crossed his path, especially to those hospitalized. It didn't matter at which hospital or what time of night or day, he would be there to strengthen their faith. He is well known in the Detroit area and received The State of Michigan Special Tribute Award from Senator Jacky Vaughn in 1980.

Rev. Henlon was called to his heavenly home on March 12, 2018. He leaves behind one sister, children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, nieces, nephews, fellow pastors, church family and friends.

We have lost someone who models and lived true to his spiritual convictions, his faith, and his church.

Rev. Henlon, we love you. Receive your crown and take your rest in the arms of your savior, Jesus our Lord.

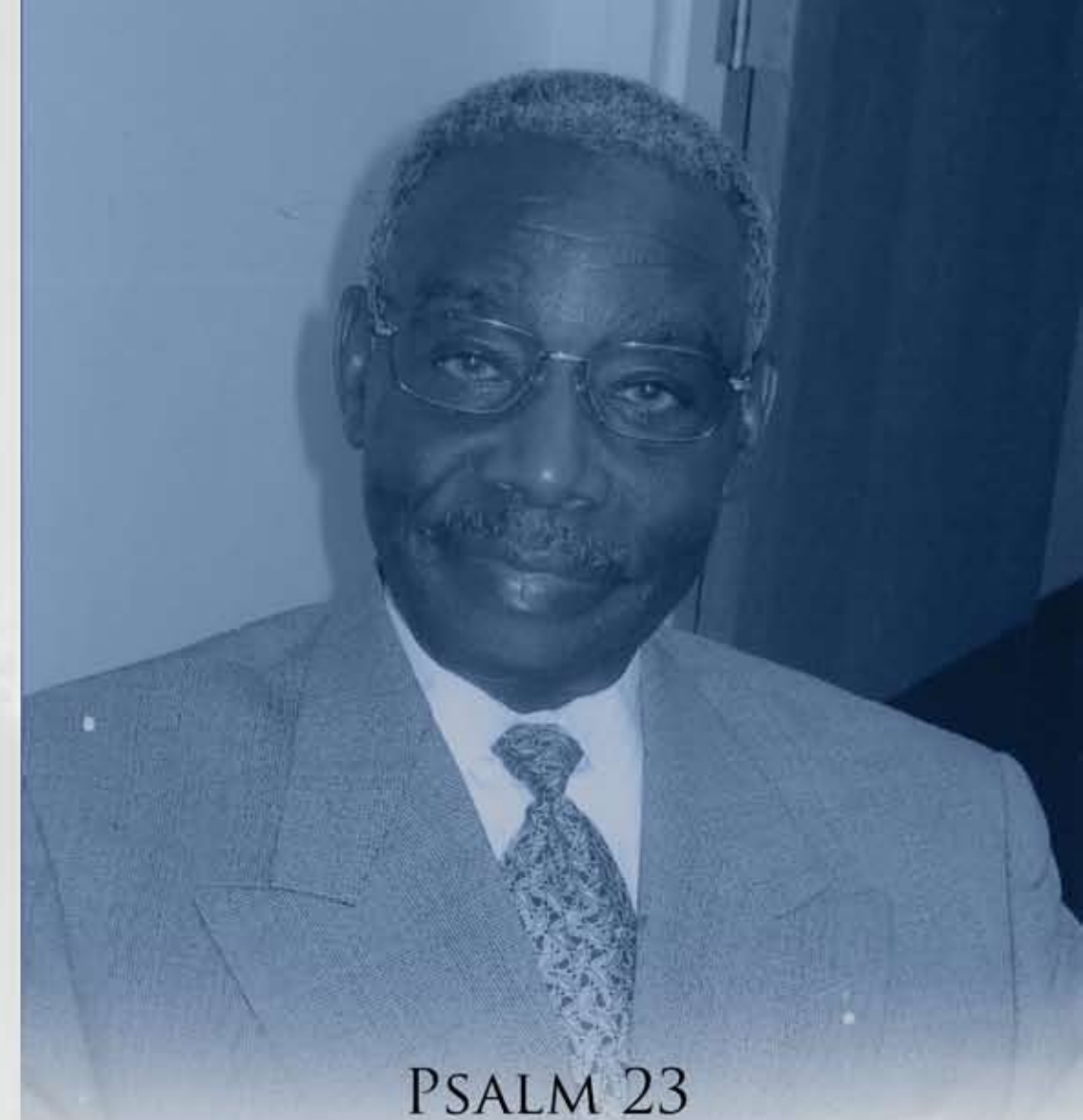
