

The Rancho Santa Margarita-based Beth Whitlinger Interior Design firm took on the challenge of remodeling a master bathroom in a 1950s ranch-style home in Cowan Heights. The first step was to create a more spacious, spa-like feeling by raising the fluorescent lighting ceiling to the roofline, and relocating back-to-back vanities to an outside wall. A Roman tub and shower occupy the same space, allowing for a new, deluxe walk-in closet. Travertine, granite, glass, and metal tiles in soothing pale greens, oatmeal and silver add a soft, shimmery, underwater quality to the room.
