White Wines:

#1 - Essay Chenin Blanc, 2019, Western Cape, South Africa

This is Chenin Blanc blended with a little Viognier and Roussanne. It offers fresh, bright citrus tones on the nose with elements of white peach skin, citrus blossom and wax melon in the glass. Medium-bodied, the palate is refreshing, offering delicate layers of stone fruit, citrus and a balanced structure, ending with a delightful, crisp finish. \$13

#2 - Do Zoe Albariño, 2019, Rias Baixas, Spain

This beauty from the west coast of Spain has a fragrant bouquet of mineral, spring flowers, citrus, and tropical notes. With excellent volume, intense flavors, and lively acidity, this tasty Albariño will drink well for another year and pair with burrata and pesto, Caesar salad, and fish tacos. \$15

#3 - Kaltern "K" Bianco, 2019, Trentino - Alto Adige, Italy

WAY over delivers for the money. Robert Parker's Wine Advocate gave it 88 points and said, "The Cantina Kaltern 2019 K White is a value blend of 40% Pinot Bianco, 30% Chardonnay and 30% Sauvignon Blanc. The wine is quick on its feet with citrus, bitter almond, wild sage and crushed chalk or limestone. There is a pretty vein of acidity that keep it extra fresh and easy to drink. Serve it at aperitivo time with salty tortilla chips and fresh guacamole." \$13

#4 - Bonpas "Legende de Bonpas" Blanc, 2019, Luberon, France

A beautiful package that *looks* expensive, this Rhone blend has oodles of peach, brioche, honeysuckle and floral notes to go with a medium-bodied, pure, rich and layered mouth feel. This is a clean, classy white that will excel on the dinner table with pasta alfredo and rich seafood dishes or grilled chicken. \$13

#5 - Carmel Road "Unoaked" Chardonnay, 2019, Monterey, California

A perfect Springtime style of Chardonnay with no oak or malolactic fermentation. It has a pretty nose of pear blossom, red apple skin, honeycomb and chamomile with notes of peach pie and a rocky mineral note. Light to medium-bodied, it has a softly rounded texture with juicy acidity and finishes long on a floral note. \$14

#6 - Domaine La Croix Belle "Caringole" Rosé, 2020, Languedoc, France

We're delighted to kick off rosé season with this beauty from the fantastic 2020 vintage (probably the best thing to come out of 2020). Reminds us of Provence without the price tag. It offers pretty scents of tangerine, peach and lime on the nose. It's light to medium-bodied, balanced and zesty and a perfect match to salmon, veggie skewers on the grill and nicoise salad. \$14

Red Wines:

#7 - Sidewise Pinot Noir, 2019, Languedoc, France

This little cutie pie has a deep ruby color, a pretty nose of red raspberry and cherry, a hint of dusty cocoa on the palate and a soft, lush finish with no hard edges. It's a perfect wine to enjoy while watching TV with some popcorn or paired with ham and grilled asparagus. \$11

#8 - Torres "5G Cinco Garnachas", 2017, Campo de Borja, Spain

The 5G represents five generations of the Torres family making wine in Spain. The wine has lovely strawberry and kirsch notes, medium body, and loads of fruit in an easy to understand, delicious, savory style. It's delicious with rotisserie chicken, mushroom dishes and pork tenderloin. \$15

#9 - Vignamato Rosso Piceno, 2019, Marche, Italy

This fruit forward blend of 80% Montepulciano and 20% Sangiovese is incredibly versatile on the dinner table. It possesses a deep ruby color as well as a big, rich nose of strawberry jam, sweet and sour cherries, roasted herbs and underbrush. It's fabulous paired with pizza, classic Italian fare, burgers and barbecue. \$12

#10 - Balcon de Los Andes Malbec, 2017, Mendoza, Argentina

This Malbec with a couple of years of cellaring is dark ruby in color with blackberry, cedar, pencil shavings, and spice notes. Firm on the palate, with good balance, it has ample ripe fruit and enough structure to drink well for 5-7 years. Pair it with grilled meats, stuffed jalapeno or spicy bean burgers. \$12

#11 - Ozwell Family Shiraz / Cabernet Sauvignon, 2018, Riverina, South Australia

Deep garnet colored, this 50/50 blend of Cabernet & Shiraz has scents of warm black plums, cassis, blueberry preserves and dried mint with touches of baking spices and pepper. Medium to full-bodied, it is well balanced with a medium level of soft, ripe tannins, and a long finish. \$14

#12 - McManis Cabernet Sauvignon, 2019, Lodi California

Another family winery that always over delivers, this Cabernet is full throttle & dark garnet in color with a bouquet full of blueberry, blackberry and black cherry notes and a hint of smoke. Medium-bodied on the palate with juicy black currant and black cherry flavors, it finishes with rounded, creamy tannins and a hint of mocha. \$13
