Michigan Laborers' Scholarship Fund 2022-2023 Scholarship Program

The Michigan Laborers' Scholarship Fund is pleased to announce the 2022-2023 Scholarship Program, which provides scholarships for the continued and further education of eligible individuals who have been admitted or are already enrolled as a student in an accredited post-secondary institution. **Applications must be received by the fund office on or before May 1st, 2022 to receive full consideration.**

In general, eligible individuals who may apply for a scholarship under the Scholarship Program are members in good standing of a Local Union affiliated with the Michigan Laborers' District Council, their biological children, grandchildren, adopted children, stepchildren, a person for whom the member or spouse is or was named full legal guardian (other than a limited or temporary guardian), or survivors of deceased members who were members in good standing of a Local Union affiliated with the Michigan Laborers' District Council at the time of their death. Survivors include all persons listed above. Eligible individuals must also have been admitted or be already enrolled in an accredited vocational school, technical school, or a two or four-year degree granting college or university accredited by the Board of Education.

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SCHOLARSHIP RULES

- 1) Monetary Scholarship awards will be made annually by the Michigan Laborers' Scholarship Fund ("Fund") to students selected by the Scholarship Committee of the Fund. The amount and the number of scholarships awarded will be determined each year by the Board of Directors of the Fund based primarily on available funds. The Board of Directors is not obligated to award any specific portion of the funds available in a given year. When provided by special donations, or if additional funds are available, additional scholarships may be awarded.

Recipients will be selected from among those who submitted completed applications by May 1 at the sole discretion of the Scholarship Committee.
- 2) Applicants must be pursuing their education in an accredited vocational school, technical school, or a two or four-year degree granting college or university accredited by the Board of Education of the state where the school is located. Applicants attending graduate school will also be considered.
- 3) Applicants must be members in good standing of a Local Union affiliated with the Michigan Laborers' District Council, their biological children, grandchildren, adopted children, stepchildren, a person for whom the member or spouse is or was named full legal guardian (other than a limited or temporary guardian), or survivors of deceased members who were members in good standing of a Local Union affiliated with the Michigan Laborers' District Council at the time of their death. Survivors include all persons listed above. Applicants must also meet other eligibility criteria established by the Scholarship Committee (such as the applicants' character, extracurricular activities, scholastic ability, and achievement).
- 4) The following individuals and relatives of the following individuals are not eligible to apply for or be awarded a scholarship from the Fund:
 - a. Current members of the Board of Directors of the Fund.
- 5) Scholarship awards will be made by check payable jointly to the student and to the school at which the student is enrolled and will be given to the student. The school will be notified that the award has been made, subject to the student remaining in good standing, and requesting notification if the student withdraws. If the annual tuition is less than the amount awarded, the balance may be used to purchase books or materials relating to the students course of study.
- 6) The Scholarship Committee will base its decisions on the applicants' character, activities, scholastic ability, and achievement. Scholarships are awarded without regard to gender, race, religion, sexual orientation, disability, or political affiliation of the applicant.
- 7) If the scholarship cannot be used for the immediate scholarship year due to unforeseen circumstance, the committee, at its sole discretion may permit the scholarship to be used the following scholarship year. No award will be made, if, in the judgment of the committee, no applicant is properly qualified.
- 8) Completed applications must be submitted to the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee no later than May 1 of each year.
- 9) The applicant must submit a brief biographical essay describing experiences, achievements, how the Laborers have benefited their family's lives, and career objectives with the application form.
- 10) The applicant must submit a transcript of grades received during prior years of high school or college.
