Sparkling, White & Rosé Wines:

#1 – Codorníu Cava, NV, Penedès, Spain

One of the oldest producers in Spain (founded in 1551!), Codorníu still overdelivers on value. This traditional-method sparkler is dry and bright, with citrus and green apple notes, a touch of toast, and very fine bubbles. It's perfect as a celebration starter or paired with salty snacks, sushi, or fried apps. Classic, clean, and way underpriced for the quality. \$12

#2 – Anjos Vinho Verde, 2024, Minho, Portugal

This light, slightly fizzy white is summer in a glass. Vinho Verde ("green wine") is all about freshness, and this one delivers lime zest, green apple, and a kiss of spritz. Super low alcohol and super refreshing—it's made for patio sipping, ceviche, or anything coming off a grill. \$11

#3 – La Carraia Orvieto Classico, 2024, Umbria, Italy

A crisp, charming white from central Italy, Orvieto is a longtime favorite that flies under the radar. This one is dry and light-bodied, with white peach, almond, and soft floral notes. Easy to drink and easy to pair—think white pizzas, chicken piccata, or creamy pastas. \$15

#4 – Patient Cottat "Le Grand Caillou" Sauvignon Blanc, 2023, Loire Valley, France

From the land of Sancerre, this is a Loire Valley Sauvignon Blanc with all the right stuff—zesty citrus, crushed stone, and a touch of white flower. It's bright, expressive, and just the right amount of lean. Try it with goat cheese, oysters, or a big veggie platter. \$14

#5 – Toad Hollow Chardonnay, 2024, Mendocino, California

Unoaked and easygoing, this Chardonnay is all about purity of fruit. You'll get juicy pear, golden apple, and a citrus pop without any buttery heaviness. It's clean and vibrant, perfect for fans of white Burgundy or Chablis-style Chard. Great with grilled shrimp, crab cakes, or roast chicken. \$15

#6 – Natura Rosé, 2024, Central Valley, Chile

Organically farmed and super tasty, this pale pink beauty has aromas of strawberries, raspberries, and citrus peel. It's dry, crisp, and vibrant, with just the right fruitiness for pairing with everything from spicy tacos to charcuterie boards. Bonus points for being planet-friendly. \$13

Red Wines:

#7 – Rickshaw Pinot Noir, 2022, California

Rickshaw consistently punches above its weight, and this California Pinot is no exception. It's silky and supple with juicy cherry and raspberry fruit, a touch of cola, and subtle earthy spice. Light enough for salmon, but flavorful enough for pork tenderloin or mushroom pasta. A total crowd-pleaser. \$12

#8 – Domaine Corne Loup Côtes du Rhône, 2024, Rhône Valley, France

Classic southern Rhône red made mostly from Grenache, with a splash of Syrah and Mourvèdre. It's warm and savory with blackberry fruit, dried herbs, and a little peppery kick. Medium-bodied and super versatile—try it with grilled meats, sausages, or anything with rosemary. Rustic in the best way. \$15

#9 – Cavalo Barão Vinho Tinto, Portugal

A liter of juicy Portuguese red for this price? Yes, please. This smooth, dark-fruited blend has soft tannins, plum and blackberry flavors, and a little earthy finish. Nothing fancy—just honest, drinkable red wine that's perfect for pizza night, burgers, or feeding a group without breaking the bank. \$11 (Liter!)

#10 – Terra Única Reserva Tempranillo Merlot, 2020, Valencia, Spain

This bold Spanish blend brings richness and polish in all the right ways. Tempranillo gives structure and spice, while Merlot softens things out with ripe black fruit. Notes of plum, cedar, and mocha make it great for fall dinners—think roast meats, lamb, or stew. Feels way more expensive than it is. \$12

#11 – Andeluna “Raíces” Malbec, 2024, Mendoza, Argentina

The high-altitude fruit gives this Malbec its signature lift—bold but balanced. Expect blackberry and blueberry fruit, a little violet and spice, and a smooth finish. Great with steak (of course), but also awesome with empanadas or grilled portobellos. Another killer value from Andeluna. \$14

#12 – El Libre Cabernet Sauvignon, 2024, Mendoza, Argentina

This is the everyday Cab that delivers way more than you'd expect for the price. Ripe dark berries, a little cocoa, and a whisper of spice make it easy to enjoy solo or with food. Medium-bodied and smooth, it's ideal with burgers, BBQ chicken, or meatloaf. Totally unpretentious and ready to go. \$11
