Sparkling, White & Rosé Wines:

#1 – Palazzo Bianca Sparkling, NV, Veneto, Italy

A fun, easygoing Italian sparkler that's all about freshness and charm. It's made from Glera, the Prosecco grape, and some other local grape varieties. Light bubbles carry notes of green apple, pear, and a hint of citrus. Clean, lively, and super drinkable, it's perfect for brunch, aperitivo hour, or mixing into a spritz. \$12

#2 – Marqués de Riscal Verdejo, 2024, Rueda, Spain

One of Spain's most iconic producers, Marqués de Riscal has been making wine since the 1800s. Their Verdejo is crisp and expressive, with citrus, green apple, and a subtle herbal note. Bright and refreshing, it's a natural with seafood, salads, or veggie dishes. \$15

#3 – Crowded House Sauvignon Blanc, 2025, Marlborough, New Zealand

From Marlborough, New Zealand's most famous Sauvignon Blanc region, this wine delivers that classic style at a great value. Bursting with passionfruit, lime, and tropical notes, it's vibrant and refreshing with a clean finish. Perfect for oysters, goat cheese, or sunny afternoons. \$15

#4 – Losito e Guarini "La Piera" Bianco, 2024, Lombardy, Italy

A charming northern Italian white that's light, smooth, and easy to enjoy. Expect soft notes of citrus, pear, and white flowers with a gentle, refreshing finish. A great match for light pastas, grilled chicken, or simple antipasti. \$12

#5 – McManis Chardonnay, 2024, River Junction, California

A longtime guest favorite, McManis delivers a round, fruit-forward Chardonnay with notes of ripe apple, pear, and a touch of vanilla. Smooth and satisfying without being heavy, it pairs beautifully with roast chicken, creamy pastas, or seafood dishes. \$14

#6 – Famaey Rosé of Malbec, 2025, Cahors, France

A rosé with a little extra personality, made from Malbec in southwest France. Bright strawberry and raspberry notes meet a crisp, refreshing finish. It's vibrant, food-friendly, and a great pick for spring gatherings, grilled shrimp, or charcuterie. \$13

Red Wines:

#7 – Donovan-Parke Pinot Noir, 2024, California

Smooth, silky, and super approachable, this California Pinot delivers cherry, raspberry, and a touch of spice. Light to medium-bodied and easy to pair, it's great with salmon, roast chicken, or mushroom dishes. \$14

#8 – Esteem by Borsao Red Blend, 2022, Campo de Borja, Spain

From the Garnacha heartland of Spain, Borsao is known for delivering big flavor at great prices. This blend shows juicy red and dark fruit with hints of spice and a smooth, generous finish. Perfect for grilled meats, burgers, or tapas night. \$13

#9 – Long Little Dog Rouge, 2022, Vin de France

A playful, easy-drinking French red that's all about pure enjoyment. A Cotes-du-Rhone look-alike, it has soft red berry fruit, a smooth texture, and a friendly, approachable style that make it great for just about anything. Try it with pizza, casual dinners, or a relaxed night in. \$12

#10 – Antinori Santa Cristina Rosso, 2023, Tuscany, Italy

From the legendary Antinori family, this Super Tuscan blend of Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon & friends has been a staple for decades. Cherry, plum, and a touch of spice come together in a smooth, balanced wine that shines with pasta, roasted meats, or classic Italian dishes. \$14

#11 – Rosendo Malbec Reserva, 2022, Mendoza, Argentina

This reserva-level Malbec brings extra depth and polish, with rich blackberry, plum, and a hint of cocoa. Full-flavored and smooth, it's a natural partner for steak, grilled meats, or hearty comfort food. \$15

#12 – Roto Cabernet Sauvignon, 2023, Maule Valley, Chile

A bold and satisfying Cabernet from Chile's Maule Valley. Dark berry fruit, a touch of spice, and a smooth, rounded finish make it a great everyday red. Perfect for burgers, BBQ, or a cozy night with friends. \$15
