



PLEASE READ! SAFETY PROTOCOLS



We take pride in our facility and how it operates. The safety of our students, teachers, and community is our number one priority. Based on the responses from parents and faculty and mandatory health and safety protocols from local and state government, we have implemented new safety procedures that all students and families must adhere to. We would like to highlight the policies we have put in place to help our dance families stay healthy and safe.

Occupancy in the Studios

We are very fortunate to have a large studio space, enabling us to not only reserve a 6'x6' space for each and every one of our dancers, but we will also ensure that the 6'x6' spaces directly in front, in back, and to each side of them will be empty as well for optimal distancing while dancing. **Masks will be required for teachers and students.** A rigorous cleaning routine will be maintained as detailed below, and for those families who do not yet feel comfortable returning to the studio, our complete 2020-2021 schedule will also be available on Zoom. Students who may have been exposed to the COVID-19 virus and need to quarantine for 14 days or need to stay home for any other reason will be able to use Zoom to continue with their classes online seamlessly.

Cleaning and Sanitization

- We will maintain a Cleaning Log for the lobby, bathrooms, and studios.
- In our studios, we have specially designed Vita-Vibe barres which are aluminum barres that are powder coated, providing an anti-microbial quality which helps to prevent the spread of germs.
- The barres, floors, doorknobs, pianos and any other 'high touch' surfaces will be cleaned after each class.
- There will be a hand sanitation station upon entering the building and in each studio.

If, at any point, it is not safe to offer in-person classes at all, we will move all classes to a virtual-only format.

We will remain vigilant in our efforts to keep our studios a safe place for everyone. The wellbeing of our students and families is our top priority, and we hope each and every one of you will take the personal steps required to stay well! Please know that we are here to address any concerns or issues, and are happy to hear from you on additional ways we can keep our community healthy!

Arrival & Screening

Upon arrival, dancers will have their temperature taken by a staff member.

Parents should be aware that students will not be allowed to stay and take class if:

- They have a temperature of more than 100.4 degrees F.
 - They have had a positive COVID-19 test in the past 14 days.
 - They have experienced COVID-19 symptoms in the past 14 days.
 - They have been exposed to COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
 - They or a family member have traveled to/from a "hot-spot" in the past 14 days.
- All students and staff are required to:
- Arrive in your dance dress code, except shoes, as lobby and dressing room capacity will be limited.
 - Wear a mask during entrance/exit and for the duration of class. Students will be excused from class if they need a short mask break.
 - Use hand sanitizer upon entering.
 - Stay home if you or a family member is sick or may have been exposed to COVID-19; You can take the class online or a make-up class another week.

We ask that students are dropped off and picked up in the parking lot. If you feel the need to walk your child in, you may wait to make sure they are cleared for class, but we ask that you find another place to wait during your child's class.

One parent may wait in the lobby only for students ages 3 & 4.
