This four hour workshop is designed for dancers beginning pointe this summer. It will cover all of the basics of pointe shoes including selecting the right fit, sewing and tying shoes, pointe safety and how to care for pointe shoes. The class, taught by Sarah Komara will also include a beginning pointe technique class that will prepare dancers for summer classes.

This is a **mandatory workshop** for any APSD dancers starting pointe in the summer session. Cost is \$65. Dancers must have permission from the Studio Director or Assistant Studio Director prior to beginning pointe. Please do **NOT** sew shoes prior to workshop. Shoes must be approved by one of the directors before the start of the workshop.

- Pointe Shoe Care
- Pointe Shoe Safety
- Beginning Pointe Technique

Dancers will need to bring pointe shoes, shoe elastic and Freed brand ribbon (available at the studio) as well as a stitch kit for sewing.
