FINISHING LVP STAIR TREADS WITH TILE RISERS

When installing Luxury Vinyl Plank (LVP) on stair treads with tile risers, a clean and professional

finish is essential for both safety and design. Here are recommended finishing options:

1. Stair Nose Molding (Best Practice):

- Use a coordinating stair nose to cap the front edge of the tread.
- Choose between overlapping or flush mount styles.

2. Schluter Edge Trim:

- Ideal for clean transitions between tile and LVP.
- Metal trims (like Schluter Rondec or Jolly) offer modern looks and durability.


3. Caulk and Paint Match (Budget Option):

- Use color-matched caulk to seal the edge temporarily.
- Not recommended for long-term durability.

4. Decorative Wood Trim:

- Adds character and softness to transitions.
- Works well with transitional and warm design styles.

Always ensure stair nose molding is used on treads for safety and to prevent wear.



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
