RARE FINDS

CHATEAU D’YQUEM “Y”, 2014, BORDEAUX, FRANCE *Incredibly Rare!!!*
2014, Bordeaux, France 55 / 280
*“It has an attractive nose with scents of nettle, dandelion, gooseberry and grass clippings,
the Semillon taking a back seat to the Sauvignon Blanc at the moment. The palate is
very well balanced with the 20% new oak nicely integrated (the remainder is matured in
two-year-old Yquem barrels). It is very refined with lovely passion fruit and kumquat notes
towards the second half where finally the Semillon makes its presence felt, with touches
of brioche and lemongrass developing in the glass. What a gorgeous Ygrec.”*

MARSTON FAMILY VINEYARD CABERNET SAUVIGNON
2005, Spring Mountain District, Napa Valley, California 30 / 66 - 375ml
*“The 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon is a beauty. Aged in 400-liter puncheons (as winemaker
Philippe Melka believes the larger size helps tame some of the naturally high tannins
from this mountain site), this wine exhibits a deep ruby color, a beautiful nose of melted
licorice, spring flowers, cassis, and hints of blueberry and chocolate. It is elegant, full-
bodied., refreshing, and intense. The wine was completely fermented and aged in
puncheons before bottling. It should drink nicely for at least 12-15+ years.”*
