***** This will be a physically demanding deployment that requires backpacking with a 40lb pack over a total of 40 miles. As reflected in our policies, Soul River Inc takes health and safety seriously and will work with participants to determine participation and assure ability to succeed on this deployment.*

SRI retains the right to change the participant schedule at any time even if a participant was selected for a deployment. All considerations will be made to give as much notice as possible to respect schedules and planning. The above dates may change by a day or two based on on-location and travel logistics.
