Simple Rules

- Lay out the *Little Green Apples Toss'n Towel* on a flat surface
- Competitors toss from opposite ends of the towel to the appropriate far target
- Select an equal tossing distance from both ends of the towel
- Start playing
- First to 21 wins
- Adjust the rules to your preference

Extra Challenge Rules:

Use one or more of these rules to kick up the fun!

- *Toss'n Sack* must land completely within the target; on or over the line does not count
- If your *Toss'n Sack* lands completely within your Apple target, add a point
- If your *Toss'n Sack* touches any part of the leaf at the top of your apple, you don't get three; and you lose a point
- Try out your own variations!
