Toss'n Baseball™ Game Play

Please Note:

Many people like to make up their own rules for the game, or invent new ways to play. Go ahead! You have my permission! It's what makes the *Toss'n Towel Game Towel* so much fun. Below are some games and rules we've come up with. Feel free to modify them to suit you. Simple Rules

- Lay out the *Toss'n Baseball* towel on a flat surface
- Assign point values to the targets (First Base, Second Base, etc.)
- Select your tossing distance
- Start playing
- First to 21 wins
- Adjust the rules to your preference

Advanced Game One – Hit for the Cycle

The object of this game is to get a single, double, triple, homerun and grand slam in consecutive order

- Lay out the *Toss'n Towel Baseball Towel* on a flat surface
- Choose your tossing distance
- Each player tosses one *Toss'N Sack* attempting to land closest to the center of the Grand Slam circle; closest goes first
- This game is played in "innings" with four tosses per player, alternating between players
- Each player tries to hit for the cycle in sequence: single, double, triple, homerun and grand slam
- Once you've achieved each goal, attempt the next target in sequence
- First to Grand Slam at the end of an inning wins

Extra Challenge Rules:

Use one or more of these rules to kick up the fun!

- *Toss'n Sack* must land completely within the target; on or over the line does not count
- If your opponent's *Toss'n Sack* touches and remains in contact with yours in any target representing the highest target you've achieved that inning, it negates that target achievement unless you touch your opponent's *Toss'N Sack* on a subsequent toss in that inning
- A player, whose *Toss'n Sack* lands anywhere on the pitcher's mound, sends their opponent back to first base, all other progress is lost; *OR* opponent goes back one base in progress
- A player, whose *Toss'n Sack* lands anywhere in the Strike Out zone, loses one toss in that inning (unless it was the last toss); *OR* goes back one base in progress
- Try out your own variations!

Game Two – Toss’n Towel Homerun Crush

Battle it out with your friends, just like in the big leagues.

- Lay out the *Toss’n Towel Baseball Towel* on a flat surface
- Choose your tossing distance
- Each competitor tosses one *Toss’n Sack*, attempting to land closest to the center of the Grand Slam circle; closest goes first
- Players alternate tossing one *Toss’n Sack* at a time, attempting to land their sack completely within the Homerun section; on or over the line does not count
- First to 21 wins the title of *Homerun Beast*

Game Two Variation – Speed Round (best played with extra *Toss’n Sacks*)

Go side by side, head to head with a friend in this fast-paced dual-player competition.

- Each competitor tosses one *Toss’n Sack*, attempting to land closest to the center of the Grand Slam circle; closest chooses the left or right tossing position
- On signal, both players begin to toss
- First player to finish tossing all of their *Toss’n Sacks* first ends the game
- Variation: You have 15 seconds to toss all of your *Toss’n Sacks*
- Player with the most *Toss’n Sacks* completely inside the *Homerun* section wins the title of *Homerun Beast*; on or over the line does not count

Game Three – Toss’n Towel Strikeout Ace

Be a big league pitching ace! Even play as your favorite pitcher. Get more strikeouts than your opponent and win!

- Use the Homerun Crush rules, but use the Strike Out target zone
- Pitch nine innings of four tosses each, alternating tosses with your opponent
- Most strikeouts? You win Pitching Ace bragging rights!
- This game can also be played using the Speed Round rules
- *Alternate rule for non-Speed Round*: don’t touch the Grand Slam area; if you do, you lose one toss
