

## Beer Descriptions – Summer 2017

ABV = Alcohol by Volume (higher = more alcohol)  
IBU= International Bitterness Units (higher = more hops)

### Tin Whiskers Brewing “Decennial” Infused American Wheat Ale (St. Paul, MN)

\$6

- **SELECT TAP BEER.** 16 oz pour. 5.4% ABV. 12 IBUs. Infused American Wheat Ale.
- *Description:* Decennial is back! HideAway collaborated with Tin Whiskers to create this beer for our 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary in 2016. Decennial is a wheat ale brewed with honey and chamomile, then infused with cucumber, rosemary, orange and lime zest.

### Take 16 “Country Mile” Kolsch (Luverne, MN)

\$5

- 12 oz bottle. 4.6% ABV. 13 IBUs. Kolsch.
- *Description:* German inspired ale that’s pale in color and crisp in flavor. A delicate and fruity bouquet makes it both thirst quenching and desirable.

### Bauhaus Brew Labs “Wagon Party” Lager (Minneapolis, MN)

\$4

- 12 oz can. 5.4% ABV. 55 IBUs. West Coast Lager.
- *Description:* Fermented with lager yeast at higher ale temperatures, this beer is homage to an American beer style that emerged during the California Gold Rush. Its firm, grainy maltiness and hoppy aroma of tangerine, apricot and citrus will make you want to party like it’s 1849.

### Indeed Brewing “Lucy’s Sour” (Minneapolis, MN)

\$4

- 12 oz can. 4.2% ABV. 27 IBUs. Session Sour Ale.
- *Description:* Lucy is a sassy and unpredictable light body session sour ale with lush tropical fruit and a tart and citrusy finish; brewed with lemongrass, orange peel and passion fruit.

### Surly Brewing “Rising North” American Pale Ale (Minneapolis, MN)

\$6

- 16 oz can. 5.4% ABV. 25 IBUs. APA.
- *Description:* Featuring bright, citrusy hops and a warming malt base, this is the official beer of Minnesota United. On game day, or any other, forever United, together.

### Modist Brewing “Dreamyard” IPA (Minneapolis, MN)

\$8

- 16 oz can. 7.1% ABV. 50 IBUs. American IPA.
- *Description:* A hazy, super juicy IPA made from oats and wheat.

### Bad Weather Brewing “Windvane” Red IPA (St. Paul, MN)

\$5

- 12 oz can. 6% ABV. 65 IBUs. Red Ale.
- *Description:* A deep brilliant red, hoppy brew with swift bitterness and piney, citrus and resinous flavors. Roast malt layers add complexity and keep the beer dry to showcase the hops.

### Bent Paddle “14° ESB” Amber Ale (Duluth, MN)

\$5

- 12 oz can. 5.6% ABV. 32 IBUs. Extra Special Bitter Amber.
- *Description:* Our ESB is incredibly well balanced with a slight toasted malt flavor, traditional British hop accents with just a hint of pine and citrus from the unexpected Amarillo/Ahtanum dry-hop.

### Toppling Goliath Brewing “Rover Truck” Oatmeal Stout (Decorah, IA)

\$5

- 16 oz can. 5.7% ABV. 35 IBUs. Oatmeal Stout.
- *Description:* This approachable oatmeal stout starts with a smoothing aroma of toasted almonds up front. A lively medley of roasted barley, dark malts, and hints of dry chocolate mingle within this mild, but chewy, oatmeal body for a relaxed and well-balanced stout.

### Sweetland Orchard “Cherry Rhubarb Scrumpy” Hard Cider (Webster, MN)

\$8

- 12.7 oz bottle. 6.95% ABV. No IBUs. Hard Cider.
- *Description:* It started as a way to use the extra rhubarb from the garden, but this rosy refresher quickly became an indisputable favorite. Just the right mix of fruit and bite.
