Policy	<p>The following appearance and grooming guidelines are to help ensure not only a professional appearance, health and sanitation compliance, and consistency throughout the crew, but also a reflection of our standard for excellence.</p> <p><u>Clothing</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Clean, tidy and professional appearance is required at all times.➤ Shoes must be closed toe <p><u>Appearance/Grooming</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Hair needs to be cleaned, combed and neatly styled, long hair needs to be pulled back and up off the collar.➤ Minimal Jewellery. A watch and single earring in each ear is acceptable.➤ Nail varnish is not permitted. <p><u>Events Clothing</u></p> <p>When working at staffed events - chefs, production chefs and station chefs are required to be well groomed and clean shaven and wear clean, black dress pants, socks and shoes (clean black runners are acceptable). Kitchen staff that work on staffed events should carefully read the Service Appearance and Grooming Policy..</p> <p><u>Sanitation</u></p> <p>Proper sanitation practices must be followed at all times</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Please wash your hands!➤ Use gloves when handling any food or serving equipment!➤ NO GUM CHEWING
