San Francisco, CA
The deep amber color, thick creamy head, and rich flavor. Since 1896.
ABV: 4.9% 7

O Mission Lager (Gluten-Free) (Bottle)

Widmer Brothers Brewing Company, Oregon
One of the best Gluten-Free Lagers I have tasted. Citrus taste in the hops arena. Clean, crisp light, easy-drinking!

Samuel Adams Boston Lager (Draft)

Two row barley, as well as German Noble aroma hops give this beer its exclusive taste.
ABV: 4.75% 7

Köstritzer (Ko-stits-er) Black Lager, Germany (Draft)

Rated Outstanding. Not overly bitter with burnt and roasted malt characteristics. Instead, hops are used for a good portion of the bitterness. Highly drinkable.
ABV: 4.8% 7

Hefeweizen/American Wheat

“Hefs” German style of wheat beer. Banana and cloves with an often dry and tart edge, some spiciness. Little hop bitterness.

Brau-Weisse (Bottle)

Ayinger Brewery, Germany
Full bodied, light tasting, wheat beer. Distinct banana aroma with a champagne-like sparkle.
ABV: 5.1% 6.75

Orange Wheat (Draft)

Hangar 24, Redlands, CA
Locally grown oranges make this crisp, tangy, and refreshing. The citrus aroma, light airy mouthfeel, and tangy finish are this unfiltered beer’s trademarks.
ABV: 4.6% 7

Weihenstephaner Hefeweissbier (Draft)

Brauerei Weihenstephan, Germany
The oldest existing brewery in the world, since 1040! Rich yeast taste. The original
ABV: 5.4% 7.5

Fruit / Vegetable Beer

Flavored beer, with real fruit or veggies. Low bitterness to allow the fruit or vegetable to dominate.

Purple Haze (Can)

Abita Brewing Co., Louisiana
Purple Haze is a crisp, American-style wheat beer with raspberry puree added after filtration, so you may see a raspberry pulp in the beer.
ABV: 4.2% 6.75

Not Your Fathers Rootbeer (Bottle)

Small Town Brewery
The silky, smooth and satisfying finish is unmatched in flavor. It appeals to craft beer aficionados as well as those who don’t typically drink beer but crave something unique.

Pale Ale / American Blonde

A good balance of malt and hops. Fruity and bitterness. American versions tend to be cleaner and hoppier, while British tend to be more malty and buttery.

24 Street Pale Ale (Draft)

Strand Brewing Co. South Bay, CA
Flagship Pale Ale – slightly floral, slightly fruity with a bitter finish. Clean hoppiness with a balanced mix of caramel malts.
ABV: 6.1% 7

Kona Coast Fire Rock Pale Ale (Bottle)

Kona Brewing Company, HI
A medium - to full-bodied Hawaiian Style pale ale. A deep copper color and a crisp, pronounced hop flavor and aroma.
ABV: 5.8% 7

Sierra Nevada Pale Ale (Draft)

Sierra Nevada Brewing Co. Chico, CA
Full-bodied, complex character with a fragrant bouquet and spicy flavor.
ABV: 5.6% 7

805 Blonde Ale (Draft)

Firestone Walker Brewing Co. Paso Robles
A beer crafted for the coast. 805 is a light, approachable brew. Born from an all malt recipe and finished with a touch of hops, it’s slightly sweet with a clean finish.

Their #1 selling beer! Earthy and pungent with some lemony herbals notes. A good bit of bready pale malts present. Mix in a touch of stone fruit. Dry and a light finish.

Green Flash West Coast IPA (Draft)

Green Flash Brewing Co. Vista CA
Hops include Simcoe for fruitiness, Columbus for hop pungency, Centennial for pine & Cascade for floral aroma.
ABV: 7% 7.5

Stone IPA (India Pale Ale) (Draft)

Stone Brewing, Escondido, CA
Well-respected and best-selling IPAs in the country, with citrusy, piney hop flavors and aromas, all perfectly balanced by a subtle malt character. Crisp, hoppy – rated 99 world-class.
ABV: 6.9% 7

Inclined IPA (Draft)

Santa Monica Brew Works, Santa Monica CA
Their top selling beer! Slight haze, dry finish, fruity hop presence. Peach, mango, pine and earth in a zesty bitter finish. Top it off with a great nose of citrus and tropical fruit trees!

An Imperial I.P.A. A big beer with a great malt backbone that stands up to the extreme hopping rate.

Moderately hoppy, well balanced with cascade and centennia hops. Pleasantly spicy with just enough bitterness to balance the sweetness of the crystal malt

Bear Republic Brewing Cloverdale, CA
This is a hoppy IPA. A full-bodied beer using American grains and two hops.

BELGIUMS

& Belgium-Style Ales

Witbier

A Belgian Style Ale, unfiltered and high level of wheat, that's used in the mash. Always spiced, generally with coriander, orange peel and other oddball spices or herbs in the background.

Allagash White (Draft)

Allagash Brewing Company, Portland. ME
Allagash White is unique and truly refreshing. This beer is light and slightly cloudy in appearance, with a spicy aroma.

ABV: 5% 7.75

Blue Moon Belgian Ale (Draft)

Blue Moon Brewing, CO
An unfiltered cloudy beer with coriander, orange peel, full flavor with a smooth finish.

ABV: 5.4% 7

Icelandic White Ale (Draft)

Einstök Brewery, Iceland
Located just 60 miles south of the Arctic Circle. A clean and crisp start with a smooth mouthfeel thanks to the oats, citrus and spice, round out a refreshing finish. Wheat malt, pilsner malt, oats, bavarian noble hops spiced with coriander and orange peel. One of the best white ales we ever tasted.

ABV: 5.2% 7.75

Saison / Farmhouse Ale

Tank 7, Farm House Ale (Bottle)

Boulevard Brewing, Kansas City, MO
Rated Exceptional Beer Advocate. A traditional Belgian-style farmhouse ale, beginning with a big surge of fruity aromatics and grapefruit-hoppy notes, the flavor of this complex, straw-colored ale tapers off to a peppery, dry finish.

ABV: 8.5% 7.75

Belgian Strong Pale Ale

A much higher alcohol content.
Expect a complex and powerful ale, yet delicate with rounded flavors.

Delirium Tremens (Bottle)

Brouweij Huyghe Brewery Belgium
Belgium Strong Pale Ale. Has been voted the "Best Beer in the World" big title big beer. Sweet and yeasty on the nose. Belgium yeast, big but graceful sweetness, finishes dry. Clean and crisp. Dangerously drinkable and delicious.

ABV: 8.5% 10

Duvel Golden Belgian Ale (Bottle)

Brouwerij Duvel Moortgat NV, Belgium
Complexity and depth of an ale, refreshing nature of a Pilsner. A classic! One of my Favorites!!!

ABV: 8.5% 9

Pranqster (Bottle)

North Coast Brewing, Fort Bragg, CA
A mixed culture of antique yeast strains that produce a floral nose, a full fruity flavor and a clean finish. A great American Belgian.

ABV: 7.6% 7.5

Dubbel

A rich malty beer with some spicy characteristics. Lighter than Belgium Strong Ale. Mild hop bitterness with no lingering hop flavor.

Ommegang Abbey Ale (Bottle)

Brewery Ommegang, NY
Rated World-Class! Light sweet and spicy, toffee, caramel, vanilla. Very smooth aftertaste. Surprisingly light for and ale with so much flavor. A great American Belgium! One of my favorites.

ABV: 8.2% 8

Chimay Red (Bottle)

Bieres de Chimay
(Abbaye Norte Dame de Scourmont)
A Trappist Ale with a sweet and strong taste that has a slightly apricot like aroma from the fermentation.

ABV: 7% 9

Tripel

Brewers use up to three times the amount of malt than a standard Trappist.

Chimay Triple White (Bottle)

Bieres de Chimay
(Abbaye Norte Dame de Scourmont)
Fruity notes of muscat and raisins give this beer a particularly attractive aroma which complements the touch of bitterness.

ABV: 8% 10

La Fin du Monde (Bottle)

Unibroue Brewery, Canada
It is mildly yeasty with a complex palate of malt, fruit and spice notes followed by a smooth, dry finish.

ABV: 9% 7.5

Triple Karmeliet (Bottle)

Brouwerij Bosteels Brewery, Belgium
Since 1679 at the Carmelite Monastery a great beer brewed with three kinds of grain: wheat, oats and barley. With hints of vanilla mixed with citrus.

ABV: 8.4% 9

Quadruple

Belgium Style Ale with a bigger kick of flavor and alcohol. Dark full bodied and a rich malty flavor, with low bitterness.

St. Bernardus ABT 12 (Bottle)

Refuge de Notre Dame de St. Bernard
Ebony in color, smooth, creamy and full-bodied with extreme complexity and richness of texture that is very assertive, like a warming brandy.

ABV: 10% 9

The Sixed Glass (Bottle)

Boulevard Brewing, Kansas City, MO
Rated 100 on Beer Advocate. Their Quadrupel Ale, also meant for the mature connoisseur, is a deep and mysterious libation, dark auburn and full-bodied, its sweetness deceptive. As good a Quad as I have ever had.

ABV: 10.5% 8

Belgian Strong Dark Ale

Higher in alcohol, more of an all around character than the Dark Ale. Complex but a delicate palate. Spicy and alcoholic and great to drink.

Allagash Black (Bottle)

Allagash Brewing Company ME
Torried wheat and oats, Belgian dark candi give the it a full silky mouthfeel. Roasted malts give it chocolate, toast and malty taste.

ABV: 7.5% 9.5

Chimay Grande Reserve (Blue) (Bottle)

Bieres de Chimay
(Abbaye Norte Dame de Scourmont)
Rich, brown Trappist Ale considered to be the worlds finest beer. We all agree it just makes you happy.

ABV: 9% 10

Gulden Draak Ale (Bottle)

Brouwerj Van Steenberghe N.V. Belgium
Dark creamy complex Triple. A treasure of a beer protected by the Dragon. Spot on, very smooth.

Unibroue Brewery, Canada
Well-balanced flavor profile that lingers on the palate, reminding the enthusiast of the products strength. Truly, a product of great elegance.

The Original, it is somewhat heavier (with an almost ale-like fruitiness in the malt body) and more strongly hopped.

Pale Sour Ale (Bottle)		
Brewery Ommegang, NY		
Rated Exceptional! Sweet, tart, sour play off each other very well. Nice malt and yeasty characters balancing it out as well. Light citrus (lemon), Belgian yeast and a light vinegary sourness. Mouthfeel is rich, with a nice astringent aspect.

A tart flavor profile. Gains even more funky and earthy notes from house cultures and fermentation in oak barrels. Emerges with a bright, refreshing body and au naturel rawness. Tart tart tart!
