Day 1, Fri. September 11.... Check in to the Des Moines Airport Hotel to overnight for an early morning flight.

Day 2, Sat. September 12.... Depart the Des Moines Airport for **Quebec City, Canada**. Transfer to the Princess ship to overnight. **Historic & Modern Quebec**, the ornate Château Frontenac and Champ Élysées of Québec welcome you. With an overnight stay, you'll have optimal time to explore this charming city. **(D)**

Day 3, Sun. September 13.... Spend the day in **Quebec**. Explore the Old City and admire the turrets of the exquisite Château Frontenac. Every autumn, the trees that decorate the city are ablaze with fall foliage, perfectly complemented by exquisite European architecture. **(B, L, D)**

Day 6, Wed. September 16.... **Charlottetown** Witness the astonishing beauty of the rugged red sand beaches and snack on Prince Edward Island mussels, which are renowned worldwide. Admire the island's dramatic landscape of rolling hills, pristine forests, sandy beaches, ocean coves and iconic red soil. Learn about Charlottetown's maritime history. View the Light Houses of Prince Edward Island. **(B, L, D)**

Day 7, Thurs. September 17.... **Sydney, Cape Breton Island, Nova Scotia** A rapid population expansion occurred just after the turn of the 20th century, when **Sydney** was home to one of North America's main steel mills. During both the first and Second World Wars, it was a major staging area for England-bound convoys. Cape Breton is fabled as a magical travel destination and the Port of Sydney is the gateway. Known for its beauty and unique Celtic music and culture, Sydney puts some of the island's greatest sights and attractions at your fingertips when you disembark into the Joan Harriss Cruise Pavilion. **(B, L, D)**


