### ANCHOR ANNUAL CHRISTMAS ALE (BOTTLE)

Anchor Brewing Co., San Francisco, CA  
Every year since 1975 the brewers at Anchor have brewed a distinctive and unique Christmas Ale. The Ale's recipe is different every year—as is the tree on the label. The 2020 Ale is Silky-smooth layered with flavors of chocolate, toasted marshmallow and graham crackers and fresh coffee.



### ST BERNARDUS CHRISTMAS ALE (DRAFT)

Refuge de Notre Dame de St. Bernard, Belgium  
(Rated Exceptional Beer Advocate) Belgian Strong Dark Ale, Pours a dark caramel. Nose dominated by plums, figs, dates, nutmeg, allspice, a touch of cinnamon, and some doughy malt. This is THE Christmas Ale.

### BABA BLACK LAGER (CAN)

Uinta Brewing Company, Utah  
This German Schwarzbier is one of the best black lager saround! It has flavors of dark coffee, chocolate, and subtle wood smoke. Rich malty aromas, caramel grains.....and clean freshness.

### PCH – GOLDEN MILE PORTER (CAN)

Santa Monica Brew Works, California  
Golden Milk Chocolate Porter, Aroma of caramel, biscuit, vanilla and chocolate. Did I say DELICIOUS!!!?

### GAVROCHE FRENCH RED (330ML BOTTLE)

Brasserie D St. Sylvestre, Cappel Brewery, France  
A strong, red beer, with deep toasted malt flavor and brisk hoppiness. This is a rare French example of an ale refermented in the bottle.

ABV: 8.5% 8



### JUBELALE, A FESTIVE WINTER STRONG ALE

Deschutes Brewery, Bend, OR  
(Rated World Class, Beer Advocate) Award-winning, dark, malty celebration ale with layered flavors and beautifully balanced hopping. Notes of chicory, earth, spice and fruit. A beer we will look forward to every year.

### SHINER BOCK (DRAFT)

Spoetzl Brewery, Texas (Draft)  
Tip back a bock. Brewed with rich roasted barley malt and German specialty hops, It is a lightly hopped American-styled dark lager. One of those beers that just go down easy! The highest selling beer in Texas.  
ABV: 4.4% 7



### KONA COAST FIRE ROCK PALE ALE (BOTTLE)

Kona Brewing Company, HI  
A medium - to full-bodied Hawaiian Style pale ale. A deep copper color and a crisp, pronounced hop flavor and aroma.


ABV: 5.8% 7

ABV: 5% 7




### COCONUT HIWA PORTER (CAN)

ABV: 6% 6.5



### WOODCHUCK AMBER, HARD APPLE CIDER (BOTTLE)

Middlebury, Vermont  
#1 selling Cider in America. Baked caramel apple aromas. Round and frothy with a dry-yet-fruity medium body. Tangy apple sauce like finish. (Gluten Free)  
ABV: 5% 7



### ANGRY ORCHARD ROSE

Walden, New York  
Red flesh apples from France adding a irresistible rosy blush and apple-forward taste with a refreshing dry finish.

ABV: 5.5% 7
