Introducing a new leadership component exclusively to Ohio ProStart. The intent is not to increase your workload but actually help reduce it.

What is required?

- Each educator needs to either *hold elections or ask for a volunteer* — student from your current class, either junior or senior for this newly created, Ohio ProStart leadership position.
- Can be a joint shared position between two students.
- *The student(s) needs a valid email address* to receive communication from the Ohio ProStart office.

Student's Responsibilities:

- *Promote ProStart*, including the ProStart Invitational & Burger Battle, scholarships, job opportunities, COA's, Boot Camp and other activities to their fellow students
- Communicate and engage fellow students about ProStart— *spark excitement and encourage participation*
- *Earn COA credit* for their efforts — up to 25 hours (validation required)

Why? As ProStart continues investigating the process of becoming a CTSO, leadership has always been a primary attribute that has not been specifically addressed until now with the ProStart leaders position.
