To Our Valued Customers,

Due to continued volatility in fuel costs, we find it necessary to add a fuel surcharge to all our deliveries. The surcharge is based on the United States Energy Information Administration weekly average of on highway diesel fuel price for our Central-Atlantic region. This report is posted at [www.eia.gov/petroleumgasdiesel.com](http://www.eia.gov/petroleumgasdiesel.com). As this report is updated every Tuesday, our fuel surcharge rate will lock in for the week starting with Wednesday's deliveries. The fuel surcharge will be applied as a flat fee per load for all truck types. The surcharge will be structured from a base rate of \$4.00 per gallon as follows:

We here at County Conservation Company value your business. We have structured our surcharge as conservatively as possible to offset the rapid rise in the cost of fuel for our fleet of grinders, screeners, wheel loaders, dozers, and delivery trucks. We will discontinue the surcharge when the cost of fuel drops to \$4.00 or less. We look forward to servicing your landscape material and bio-soil needs. Thank you for your continued support.
