



Prior to joining CACI in 2022, Mr. Starr served 24 years as an active duty Army officer. He began his career as an Infantryman where he established a strong foundation in how the Army trains and fights, serving in numerous positions from the platoon to division staff levels. After 12 years in the Infantry, he transitioned to Army Space Operations (FA40) where he served the remainder of his career.

Mr. Starr served as the Commander of the 4<sup>th</sup> Space Company, the Chief of Strategy and Policy at the Space and Missile Defense Command (SMDC), the Deputy Director of Space Forces for Air Forces Central Command, Executive Officer for the Commanding General at SMDC, and Chief of the Commander's Action Group at SMDC.
