Michael “Woody” Woodhouse serves as Vice President for Space, Air and Missile Defense at Leonardo DRS, where he drives enterprise strategy and advances integrated capabilities supporting the Joint Force and allied partners. He brings more than two decades of U.S. Army experience in space, air, and missile defense operations, acquisition, and international collaboration.

Before joining Leonardo DRS, Woodhouse culminated his 20 year Army career as Deputy Chief of Warfighter Integration at the Space Development Agency. In this role, he shaped major acquisition decisions, secured multi-agency alignment on next-generation missile defense architectures, and led groundbreaking efforts including the first space-based Link 16 demonstration. Woodhouse previously held senior planning and command positions across NATO, U.S. Central Command, and the Army’s air defense enterprise.

Woodhouse graduated from Niagara University with a Bachelor of Science in Commerce and Marketing. He earned his Master of Arts Degree in organizational leadership from The University of Texas, El Paso and also earned a Master of Arts in Military Studies at the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College in Fort Leavenworth, Kansas.

Woodhouse is the co-founder and President of The Patriot Bros. Association, a non-profit focused on supporting members of the Air Defense community awarding over \$100k in scholarships to date. Woodhouse is also the award winning author of the book SEAM: The Adaptive Strategy Framework for Leaders.
