



If you give us information about yourself in an e-mail or through our contact page, any information you provide is used only to help us prepare a response. As we do so, the information you provided may be viewed by various people within Flat Top Grill. The information you provide is protected in accordance with law (e.g., the Privacy Act and the Freedom of Information Act). Submitting voluntary information constitutes your consent to the use of the information for the stated purpose.

The Flat Top Grill e-mail system is password-protected. Only authorized users have access to the e-mail system and feedback mechanism.

We collect no personally identifiable information about you when you visit our site unless you choose to provide that information to us.

For the protection of users of our Web site, we have safeguards in place to identify and prevent unauthorized attempts to access or cause harm to information and systems.

Our web server automatically collects the default information logged by most servers; this information includes the Internet protocol (IP) address from which you access our web site, the type of browser and operating system you are using, the date and time you visit, the pages and files you request, and the last site you visited. We use this information to determine the level of traffic through the server and the level of interest in the individual files available on the server. None of this information identifies you personally, and we do not give, sell, or transfer any of this information to a third party.

The logs may be preserved indefinitely, and they may be used to prevent security breaches and to ensure the integrity of the data on our servers. We do not use "persistent cookies" or use any persistent tracking technologies that can identify a specific visitor, or information about that visitor, over multiple visits. Session cookies are deleted from our Web servers when your session ends.

On occasion, we contract with trusted third party providers who would receive your Personal Information to perform certain services on our behalf. Through our contractual arrangements, we require our contracting partners to maintain adequate security of Personal Information provided to them. We do not permit such third parties to sell your Personal Information to other third parties, however such third parties may share non-personally identifiable aggregate data (such as user demographics, website activity, purchase history, and other statistical information) and de-identified individual data and profiles with third parties for market research and other purposes.
