MISS RODEO OF THE OZARKS PAGEANT RULES &
ENTRY FORM

1. Candidates must be 15 thru 24 years of age, single, never been married or had a child.
2. Winner must reign as MISS RODEO OF THE OZARKS thru June 2021 and cannot accept any Rodeo or State Title (a preliminary to Miss Rodeo America or Miss Rodeo USA) during this time. To do so will forfeit title, crown and prizes.
3. Winner will be required to attend at least 10 rodeos during her reign and be introduced as Miss Rodeo of the Ozarks.
4. Candidates must be from Arkansas, Oklahoma, Missouri or Kansas.
5. Suitable western wear will always be worn. Dress pants, colored jeans (Wranglers), shirts or vests may be worn in the arena. A western dress should be worn for the Personal Interviews. Western skirt, blouse or dress may be worn for the luncheons. A schedule will be sent to you later.
6. Candidates must ride in Parade and Grand Entry June 24-25-26-27. Must attend all functions.
7. Horsemanship will be judged at the Arena.
8. Contestants will be judged on Appearance, Personality and Horsemanship.
9. Contestant must be sponsored by a Riding Club, Horse Organization or Ranch.
10. Entry form must be received by May 13 with two (2) bust photos in western attire. Must be colored photo. \$25.00 entry fee must accompany entry form.
11. Contestant will report to the Rodeo Headquarters no later than 1:00 PM on June 24.
12. Contestant must ride the same horse during the entire contest unless lameness or sickness to animal. A vet certificate will be required.
13. NO STALLIONS will be permitted by contestants.
14. Entertainment, transportation and lodging will be furnished for all contestants June 24-June 27. All meals will be furnished. Must be checked out of hotel by June 27 or 28.
15. Contestant will receive a ticket for one guest to the four performances. A chaperone will be with contestants at all times.
16. The winner will receive a saddle, headstall, breast collar, crown, roses and \$400 on June 27.

BRING WITH YOU:

Horse, saddle, equipment, feed and water buckets with snap on handles, halter and lead rope.
Be sure and label each item with your initials.

There will be NO DATING during June 24-27. Contestants that do not abide by the rules will be dismissed from the contest and asked to leave. No cell phones will be permitted. No calls will be made. In case of emergency, the chaperone may be contacted.

A stall will be furnished for each horse. However, you must have someone to take care of (feed & water) your horse and have it saddled at the proper times. You will not have time to do it yourself.

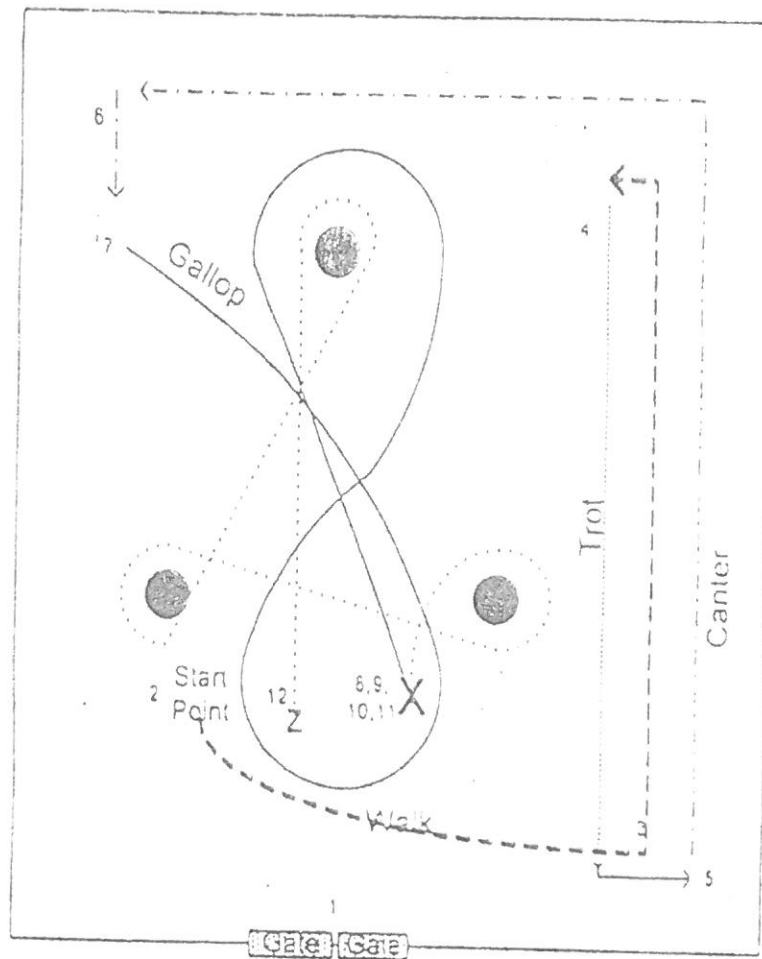
