#### JOB DESCRIPTION:

State Elevator Inspectors protect the safety of the general public from injury or death resulting from inadequately maintained, or improperly installed elevators, escalators, moving walks, dumbwaiters, amusement rides and tramways through the enforcement of applicable codes as adopted in AS 08.60.800 and applicable regulations.

Responsible for evaluation of private sector authorized Amusement Ride Inspectors and makes recommendation to section program manager in approving and licensing Amusement Ride Inspectors.

Performs inspection of amusement rides in the state to ensure safety of rides for the general public. Lead investigator of amusement ride incidents or accidents as needed.

Responsible for enforcement of the codes adopted by Alaska Statute 08.60.800 in regards to elevators, escalators, dumbwaiters and wheel chair lifts.

Responsible for performing acceptance inspections of new, remodeled or modernized devices statewide, in accordance with the applicable code for the device.

Frequent (up to 33%) travel is required.

Required certifications:

- Current Amusement Ride Inspector Level II certification from the National Association of Amusement Ride Safety Officials (NAARSO).

Desired traits:

- Current certification as a Qualified Elevator Inspector from the National Association of Elevator Safety Authorities (NAESA); or
- Four years' experience working in the elevator industry as "Qualified Elevator Personnel";
- Familiarity with inspection procedures related to amusement rides, ski-lifts, and elevator systems and apparatus;
- Ability to: Observe and analyze the job environment, equipment, or building system installation to determine if code violations are present;
- Understand, interpret, and apply regulations related to the amusement ride and elevator safety;
- Evaluate a variety of interrelated information involving existing and/or potential hazards related to the assigned area of inspection and determine the best course of action;
- Write professional reports and maintain records which may require use of a computer;
- Communicate and consult effectively with agency representatives, Federal and state officials, senior management of construction industry professionals, members of the general public;
- Effectively self-manage time and priorities to schedule workload and complete unusually difficult work;
- Work in absence of available or applicable guidelines and without daily personal supervision.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Must possess a valid Amusement Ride Inspector Level II certification from NAARSO.  
Must possess a valid driver's license.
