

Here are some practical steps to take for keeping your perception in alignment with the truth of God's word.

- Read your Bible as much as possible.
- When you read a scripture and it kind of "sticks out" to you, then write it down. Then, pray about it and talk to God about it.
- Always have your heart open to be taught by God. God speaks to us in many ways, including through His word. He really does love you.
- I would also say the scripture out loud. There's something powerful about saying it out loud! You don't need to get too deep into this but declaring the word over your life will change things. It builds your faith, and it changes the atmosphere. You can literally take authority over your life with the word.

Romans 10:17- So faith comes from hearing and hearing through the word of Christ.

God wants you to see life through His eyes. As he teaches you about who YOU are through His eyes, you will begin to see things differently. See life with hope, wisdom, and love. He will teach you your true identity in Him. I am excited about your journey. I know that as far as He has brought me, He will bring you!
