Day 1 Fri. Jun 22 Travel east to Middlebury, IN, in the midst of Amish Country. This will be our home for the next 2 nights.

Day 2 Sat. Jun 23 Our step-on guide will take us down the back roads of Amish country to learn about the simple lifestyle of the Amish. Visit Amish Shops, including an Amish bakery, wood-craft shops and quilt shops. This evening we'll be treated to dinner inside an Amish home and buggy rides. **(B,D)**

Day 3 Sun. Jun 24 We travel to Thunder Bay Resort & Elk Preserve. Enjoy a horse-drawn carriage ride through the wooded resort & elk preserve. Enjoy a 5-course gourmet dinner prepared on an antique wood-burning cook stove. We overnight at the resort. **(B,D)**

Day 4 Mon. Jun 25 Travel to Mackinaw City for a tour of the Mackinac Island area. We'll cross the 5-mile Mackinac suspension bridge, the "crown jewel" of Michigan. Then travel by ferry to Mackinac Island, home for the next 2 nights. **(B)**

Day 5 Tues. Jun 26 Enjoy a horse-drawn carriage tour of the island, followed by the Grand Hotel Buffet Luncheon. Tour Fort Mackinac. Enjoy free time on your own. **(B,L)**

Day 6 Wed. Jun 27 Travel down the Lake Michigan coastline. Visit Castle Farms. See beautiful gardens, stone buildings and towers. Visit Friske Orchards to purchase fresh fruits & fruit products. Overnight in Ludington, MI. **(B,L)**

Day 7 Thurs. Jun 28 Board the S.S. *Badger* for a ferry ride across Lake Michigan to the Wisconsin shore. Arrive in Manitowoc, WI and reboard the motorcoach for our travels back home. **(B)**
