



General Instructions for MicroRid Powder Concentrate

1. Read and understand material [safety data sheet](#) (SDS) before using this product.
2. Mix 4 oz. of MicroRid Powder with 1 gallon of water.
3. MicroRid may be applied manually with a spray bottle or garden sprayer or mechanically with an airless sprayer or fogger.
4. Use a bristle broom or scrub brush to agitate the area. Rinse if needed, otherwise spray MicroRid on and leave it.
5. MicroRid can be applied to any surface compatible with water such as floors, ceilings, walls, upholstery, rugs, carpets, duct-board, fiberglass, HVAC systems, air purification equipment and air filters.
6. If spraying on any painted or dyed surfaces or materials, test for color fastness in a small, inconspicuous area before using this product to insure satisfactory results.
7. Coverage rates will vary between 500 to 2000 sq. ft. per gallon depending on the type of surface, the surface conditions, the type of infestation and the amount of infestation. Typical coverage rates for common application methods are as follows: Spraying: 500-1000 sf/gal. Fogging: 1000-2000 sf/gal. The coverage rates stated are typical starting application rates and the coverage rates may actually be higher or lower than the stated coverage rates.
