Please be advised that Eastern Missouri Laborers' District Council and Locals 42 and 110 have determined that the one dollar and twenty-five cent (\$1.25) increase due March 2, 2020, for all Laborers except Residential Laborers and Residential Laborer Helpers working in <u>St. Louis City and County</u>, will be taken as follows:

Fifteen cents (\$.15) to the Welfare Contribution Twenty-five cents (\$.25) to the Pension Contribution Zero cents (\$.00) to the Training and Apprentice Contribution Eighty-five cents (\$.85) to the Hourly Wage Rate
