Sparkling, White & Rosé Wines:



#1 - Terre di Marca "Millesimato Bio" Prosecco, 2019, Veneto, Italy *Organically farmed!!*

This fresh, fun, lively bottle of bubbles is the perfect thing to kick off your holiday meal. It will pair perfectly with a variety of appetizers and you can toast to 2020 coming to an end. It's packaged in a fun, old school style Champagne bottle and has flavors of Golden Delicious apple, pear, apricot and melon with some floral notes as well. Cheers!! \$15

#2 - Le Noble Sauvignon Blanc, 2019, Bordeaux, France

This wine is 75% Sauvignon Blanc and 25% Semillon from the beautiful Bordeaux region on the Atlantic coast of France. It's loaded with citrus-y, grilled grapefruit and fig flavors with lovely underlying minerality in a medium-bodied, richly fruity style that possesses fine purity, texture, and length. \$12



#3 - Willm Gentil, 2018, Alsace, France

A "gentil" style wine is a field blend of grapes grown in Alsace. This bottling is a blend of 40% Pinot Gris, 30% Pinot Blanc, 20% Riesling & 10% Muscat. It bursts from the glass with a myriad of spices and yellow apple, apricot and peach pit flavors. It has a satin-texture and a medium-bodied personality that will be a superb addition to your Thanksgiving table. Don't miss it! \$15



#4 - Dr Pauly Bergweiler "Noble House" Riesling, 2019, Mosel, Germany

Looking for something with just a touch of sweetness to balance all of the richness of your Turkey day meal? This is just the thing. It has just a hint of sweetness balanced by amazing acidity that leaves your palate clean. The fruit is all green apple, orange citrus, with notes of flowers and mineral. \$13

#5 - Red Tail Ridge "Sans Oak" Chardonnay, 2019, Finger Lakes, New York

Whoa! This drinks way outside of its price point. It's sourced from two single vineyards, one of which was planted in 1960. That old vine fruit gives the wine incredible depth of flavor, great extract and loads of minerality. There's lots of Granny Smith apple fruit, pear and pineapple with a Meursault-like nuttiness. Bravo! \$14



#6 - Radley & Finch Cinsault Rosé, 2020, Western Cape, South Africa

This is definitely one of the best things to come out of 2020. It's a fresh and fun rosé that has a lovely bouquet of watermelon, strawberry, raspberry sorbet and vanilla. Lots of delicious fruit but finishes dry. \$12

Red Wines:



#7 - 10 Span Pinot Noir, 2017, Central Coast, California

I have no clue how they pull this off. It's beautifully textured, red fruited Pinot Noir with no hard edges and is just an absolute delight to drink. It'll pair amazingly well with your holiday meals and will continue to drink well for a few years. It's so delicious now, I can't imagine how you could resist it's charm. \$10



#8 - Rivarey Tempranillo Crianza, 2016, Rioja, Spain

This fresh, juicy style of Rioja is perfect for your holiday dinners. The nose shows ripe, even jammy fruit and spicy notes, with some creaminess. The palate is quite supple, with flavors of cherries, figs and some spicy notes, it's very approachable and easy to drink. \$11

#9 - Monte Antico Rosso, 2015,, Tuscany, Italy

Monte Antico means "ancient mountain" and is a tribute to Tuscany created by importer Niel Empson. A baby super-Tuscan blend of Sangiovese (the Chianti grape), Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. This perennial best buy in the wine press is filled with black cherry and plum fruit, a touch of that Italian rustic spice and loads of personality. It really shines with traditional Italian fare.\$13



#10 - Jean Pla "Le Renard" Grenache & Syrah, 2019, Roussillon, France

This wine is named for Le Renard et les Raisins (The Fox and the Grapes), a fable written in the 1600's. The wine is a blend of predominantly Grenache with some Syrah and a splash of Mourvedre. It's a charming, easy to understand style of red that would be served at your favorite French bistro. Loads of plum and raspberry fruit with some dried herbs and peppery spice. \$14

#11 - Bonterra Equinox Red Blend, 2018, California

Organically farmed!!

We featured the Chardonnay from this winery a few months ago, but this red blend will **really** knock your socks off. Made primarily of Petite Sirah and Merlot, there's also some Zinfandel and Cabernet Sauvignon in the blend. The nose is all raspberry and toast, on the palate you get big, rich notes of blackberry, brambly wild cherry, earth and spice. Firm tannin grip on the long finish. Ideal for leg of lamb, rib eye or any wild game on your Thanksgiving table. \$15

#12 - Carmel Road Cabernet Sauvignon, 2018, California

A brand new wine from the Carmel Road folks, this Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from great vineyards all over the golden state. This deep ruby/plum/purple-colored, seductive Cabernet reveals attractive jammy black cherry, blackcurrant and wood spice characteristics, a warm, generous mid-palate, an endearing texture and a long, velvety finish. This is an impressive, delicious Cabernet Sauvignon for drinking over the next 7-8 years. \$14
