## OHIO LEVEL TWO FOOD CERTIFICATION IN 7 EASY STEPS

All restaurants must have **one employee on staff** who has an Ohio Level Two Certificate in Food Protection.

1.

Student completes the ServSafe Manager course, online or in a classroom.

2.

He/She takes the ServSafe Manager exam, with a proctor either online or in a classroom.

NOTE: ServSafe Manager, Level Two online and classroom courses are approved by the Ohio Department of Health (ODH).

3.

Pass the exam!

4.

Each passing student needs to download and print the certificate by going to [www.servsafe.com](http://www.servsafe.com), clicking on the "Certificates" page and logging into his/her account.

5.

ServSafe or ODH-approved exam administrator will then send the class roster and passing scores to ODH to obtain Ohio Level Two Certificates for each student.

NOTE: Student should make sure the exam administrator completes this necessary step.

6.

Next, the ODH distributes Ohio Level Two certificates to the exam administrator.

7.

And, finally, the exam administrator distributes Ohio Level Two certificates to each student.
