CHATEAU D’YQUEM “Y”, 2014, BORDEAUX, FRANCE *Incredibly Rare!!!*
2014, Bordeaux, France 55 / 280

*“It has an attractive nose with scents of nettle, dandelion, gooseberry and grass clippings,
the Semillon taking a back seat to the Sauvignon Blanc at the moment. The palate is
very well balanced with the 20% new oak nicely integrated (the remainder is matured in
two-year-old Yquem barrels). It is very refined with lovely passion fruit and kumquat notes
towards the second half where finally the Semillon makes its presence felt, with touches
of brioche and lemongrass developing in the glass. What a gorgeous Ygrec.”

BODEGA CATENA ZAPATA “CATENA ALTA” CABERNET SAUVIGNON
2014, Mendoza, Argentina 25 / 110

*(mostly from a high site with a cooler southeast exposition): Bright dark red...offering
scents of dark berries and chocolate. Then opened quickly and gained in verve, showing
fine-grained texture and a high-altitude light touch to its spicy red and darker berry
flavors.” 92 points, Vinous*
