This step should not be avoided. If we do, we are reserving a place in our program for relapse. Pride fear and procrastination often seem an impossible barrier, they stand in the way of progress and growth. The important thing is to act and be ready to accept the reactions of those persons we have harmed. We make amends to the best of our ability. Timing is an essential part of this step. We should make amends when the opportunity presents itself, except when to do so will cause more harm. Sometimes we cannot make the amends; it is neither possible nor practical. In some cases, amends may be beyond our means. We find that willingness can serve in the lace of action where we are unable to contact the person we have harmed.



Part of learning how to live successfully is learning when we need help. In some old relationships, an unresolved conflict may still exist. We do our part to resolve old conflicts by making our amends. We want to stay away from antagonisms and ongoing resentment.

In many instances we can only go to the person and humbly ask for understanding of past wrongs. Sometimes this will be a joyous occasion when old friends and relatives prove willing to let go of their bitterness. Contacting someone who is still hurting from the burn of our misdeeds can be dangerous. Indirect amends may be necessary, where direct ones would be unsafe or endanger others. No matter what we do not injure anyone with our personal recovery.
