**JOB DESCRIPTION:**

The position requires a wide range of experience and familiarity with all systems of a commercial building. Mechanical aptitude, the ability to independently troubleshoot problems with various building systems and equipment, with focused attention in detail towards safety, security and preventative maintenance. The applicant must be fully proficient and able to work independently and unsupervised within a wide variety of trades such as Electrical, Plumbing, Grounds Care, Gardening, Painting, HVAC, Masonry, Concrete, and Carpentry.

The work generally consists of, but is not limited to, the repair and maintenance of the interior and exteriors of buildings, building components and system devices, structures, the care and maintenance of plants and grounds, including snow removal and lawns, the preventive maintenance and servicing of equipment, including, but not limited to kitchen equipment such as ovens, steam kettles, dishwashers, coffee makers, and ice machines; laundry equipment, such as washers, dryers and folding machines; HVAC equipment including both DDC and pneumatic control systems, commercial boilers and glycol systems, fire alarm systems, electronic security systems and cameras, locks, doors, gates and hardware, and the related manual physical work for all.

Applicants should be able to effectively use a computer, and be proficient with Windows software, such as Outlook, Word and Excel.

The successful applicant will be supervising, training, and working with and around prisoners regularly.

Applicants will require good organization skills, keeping their work areas clean, and

paying close attention to the security, location and inventory management of tools.
