

ORDINANCE #2018-25C

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING Chapter 199. Vehicles and Traffic Part 2. Handicapped Parking Article XII. Schedules, of the Borough Code of the Borough of Beach Haven, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey.

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to correctly identify angled and parallel handicapped parking within the Borough of Beach Haven; and

NOW THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BEACH HAVEN DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

Chapter 199 Section 48 Schedule III Angled Handicapped Parking shall be amended with the following (underscores represent additions; ~~strikethroughs~~ represent deletions):

Name of Street	Side	Location
<u>Centre Street</u>	<u>West</u>	<u>100 feet west of West Avenue, one space</u>
<u>Nelson Avenue</u>	<u>West</u>	<u>120 feet east of West Avenue, two spaces</u>
<u>Third Street</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>65 feet east of Bay Avenue, one space</u>
Second Street	North	90 feet west of Beach Avenue, one space
Second Street	North	30 feet east of Bay Avenue, one space
Second Street	South	44 feet west of Atlantic Avenue, one space
Third Street	South	32 feet west of Bay Avenue, one space

SECTION II

Chapter 199 Section 47 Schedule II Parallel Handicapped Parking shall be amended with the following (underscores represent additions; ~~strikethroughs~~ represent deletions):

Name of Street	Side	Location
Seventh Street	North	Beginning 34 feet west of Bay Avenue and running in a generally westwardly direction 22 feet
Taylor Avenue	North	Beginning 26 feet west of Seagull Lane and running in a generally westwardly direction 22 feet
Taylor Avenue	South	Beginning 66 feet east of Bay Avenue and running in a generally eastwardly direction 22 feet
Twelfth Street	North	Beginning 200 feet east of Atlantic Avenue for a distance of 18 feet running in a generally easterly direction
Twelfth Street	South	Beginning 414 feet west of Bay Avenue for a distance of 18 feet running in a generally westerly direction

SECTION III

Repealer. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency. The Clerk of the Borough is authorized to renumber and/or re-codify any sections affected by such repeal to the extent consistent with this Ordinance.

SECTION IV

Severability. If any word, phrase, clause, section or provision of this Ordinance shall be found by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, illegal or unconstitutional such word, phrase, clause, section or provision shall be severable from the balance of the Ordinance and the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION V

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication thereof after final passage according to law.
