Evacuate Using The Main Floor Musician Stand Exit Door or the Balcony-Far-Left Exit Door then take stairway to Main Floor Exit Door

All of Zone # 7 Congregation Members

Evacuate Using the 4 Rear Exit Doors; then follow the EXIT SIGNS at the ends of the hallway; down the stairway to the main floor Exit-Door
