Dear Attendees and Exhibitors,

Currently, the management staff is moving forward with preparations for the 20th Sunbelt Builders Show™ on July 15 – 16 in Grapevine, Texas. Since mid-March, we have been working with the Gaylord Texan Resort and Convention Center, our registration company and show decorator to make accommodations for a safe and quality work environment for our attendees and exhibitors.

- The hotel is implementing strict sterilization of every room, hallway, bathroom, and meeting space. Hand sanitization, touchless check-in and limited contact procedures are priorities for the facility. See the Gaylord Texan efforts [here](#).
- Show decorator, Shepard, and show management are working on conference signage and trade show floor prepping. Depending on what Governor Abbott outlines for conventions, we will implement social distancing measures (such as one-way aisles, six-foot distance reminders signage, etc.), and sanitization measures. Currently, many exhibitors are bringing branded hand sanitizers and facemasks for distribution to attendees.
- Some measures that we are considering for the registration counters include increasing our barcode scanners, adding more “Scan to Print” badge tables to reduce wait time and long lines, and plastic shields for the registration counters.

We take the health and safety of our exhibitors and attendees very seriously and are utilizing “The Governor’s Report to Open Texas” for guidance. We will make all necessary Show adjustments in the coming weeks to ensure a safe and valuable experience for everyone.
