

**Firearm Definition:** A firearm is any weapon, which will, or is designed to, or may readily be converted to expel a projectile by the action of an explosive.

**Requirements:**

1. Either the shipper or recipient must be a licensed manufacturer, licensed dealer or licensed collector and not prohibited from making such shipments by federal, state or local regulations. For FedEx International Ground® Canada and FedEx Home Delivery firearm shipments, call 1.800.633.7019 for details.
2. The shipper is a government agency shipping the firearm(s) for business purposes and not for personal use.
3. Firearms should be packaged in a sturdy outer box with sufficient cushioning material to protect the firearm and secure from movement.
4. A FedEx Express box may be used for firearm shipments but only when using FedEx Priority Overnight or FedEx Express Freight services.
5. The outside of the package **must not** be marked, labeled or otherwise identify that the package contains a firearm.
6. The shipper & recipient are required to comply with all applicable government regulations and laws as defined by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco & Firearms.
7. The shipper **must** inform the FedEx employee accepting the shipment that the package contains a firearm.

**Prohibited Firearm Shipments:**

Firearms cannot be shipped loaded or with ammunition in the same package (ammunition is considered a hazardous material and must be shipped using IATA guidelines).

Firearms cannot be shipped from you to yourself

Firearms cannot be shipped C.O.D.

Firearms cannot be shipped requiring signature release, indirect or driver released

Firearms cannot be shipped internationally or re-routed

Firearms can not be shipped via FedEx drop box, or FedEx Office location. Firearms must be picked up by courier or dropped off at a FedEx Authorized Ship Center®

**NOTE:** The following are not considered firearms and may be shipped using any FedEx shipping service:

1. Weapons that are no longer capable of firing because of age, or because the ammunition needed for the weapon is no longer manufactured or available therefore making
2. Antique, curio & replica firearms
