Matthew 17:24-27 KJV - Fish with the Coin in it's Mouth



[24] And when they were come to Capernaum, they that received tribute money came to Peter, and said, Doth not your master pay tribute?

[25] He saith, Yes. And when he was come into the house, Jesus prevented him, saying, What thinkest thou, Simon? of whom do the kings of the earth take custom or tribute? of their own children, or of strangers?



[26] Peter saith unto him, Of strangers. Jesus saith unto him, Then are the children free.



[27] Notwithstanding, lest we should offend them, go thou to the sea, and cast an hook, and take up the fish that first cometh up; and when thou hast opened his mouth, thou shalt find a piece of money: that take, and give unto them for me and thee.





Matthew 17:24-27 KJV - Fish with the Coin in it's Mouth - Questions



[24] Peter and Jesus were travelling together and came to the city of Capernaum. Tribute Money is money to pay taxes.

Q: What was Peter asked?

[25] **Q: How did Peter answer the question from verse 24?**

Peter returned to where Jesus was, pondering how they would pay the tax money because he and Jesus had no money.

Q: What did Jesus ask Peter?



[26] **Q: How Peter respond to Jesus?**

[27] **Q: What did Jesus tell Peter to do so they could get the money to pay taxes?**





Matthew 17:24-27 KJV - Fish with the Coin in it's Mouth - Answers



[24 **A:** Does your master pay tribute (tax money)?

[25] **A:** He saith, Yes.

A: whom do the kings of the earth take tribute money from their own children, or strangers?

[26] **A:** strangers.

Jesus let Peter know that he had responded correctly because the children of the King are free (they don't have to pay taxes).



[27 **A:** go thou to the sea, and cast an hook, and


- take up the fish that first cometh up; and



