



'South Beach Food & Wine Festival' comes to Broward

The 16th annual "Food Network & Cooking Channel South Beach Wine & Food Festival" will take place Feb. 22-26. Along with the dozens of events taking place in Miami, the festival will work its way into Broward County with its "Taste Fort Lauderdale Series."

Closing out the series will be the return of "Bloody Mary Branch" with new hosts David Burkia and Neil Patrick Harris. The event will kick off at noon Sunday, Feb. 26, at The Ritz-Carlton, Fort Lauderdale.

Rounding out the Fort Lauderdale series will be intimate dinner experiences hosted by Amanda Freitag and Angelo Elio; Marc Murphy and Chris Miracolo; Valerie Bertinelli, Daphne Oz, Tiftani Thiessen and Geoffrey Zakarian; and Ashley Christensen, Vivian Howard, Andrea Reusing, Gavin Pera and Ryan Cross.
