JOB DESCRIPTION:

In both an office setting and in the "field" (remote Alaskan villages), this position provides training and technical assistance to rural utility operators. This position must show initiative and an ability to work independently in the field applying specific skills in plumbing and pipefitting, electronics and electrical troubleshooting, carpentry and general building maintenance to find solutions to installation, operation and maintenance problems encountered in village water and sewer systems. This position is also called upon to provide immediate emergency response to rural Alaskan utility system.

This position must have the ability to assess the situation, formulate a plan and make appropriate decisions to follow through to completion of the project or resolution of the problem or issue.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

A valid Alaska Drivers License is required. Within 6 months of hire, the incumbent must obtain at least entry level Water Treatment, Water Distribution, Wastewater Collection certifications (18 AAC 74).

THIS POSITION REQUIRES THE INCUMBENT TO OPERATE

Company light pickup truck;
Hand and power tools;
Plumbing and pipe fitting tools and materials, including soldering, plastic pipe fusion, repair bands and clamps;
Pumps (de-watering, sewage, chemical feed, submersible water and sewer);
Personal protection equipment, including goggles, gloves, lab apron, etc.;

Digital multi-meter and amperage measurement devices;
 Laboratory water analysis test kits and meters;
 Other specialty water treatment equipment such as jar testing gang stirrer, charge analyzer or current detector;
 Calibration equipment for flow rate and specialized water treatment plant instrumentation;
 Water leak detection equipment;
 Sewer line cleaning equipment;
 Water and sewer system camera and recording equipment.
 In-shop power equipment such as drill press, bench grinder and cut-off band saw;
 In-field powered equipment such as gasoline generators and water pumps, power snake, chain saw and electric jack hammer.
