



Final Departure: 100th Bomb Group Restaurant to close

Costa Mesa, Calif. – September 28th, 2020 – After 37 years of serving the Cleveland community, 100th Bomb Group Restaurant will be closing at the end of this year. Due to the pandemic and declining demand for dining and special events venues, the property will be sold at an auction at the end of October. The 100th Bomb Group is currently open for special events and will be honoring all events through December 30th of this year. The dining room will remain closed through the end of the year.

Located adjacent to Cleveland Hopkins International Airport, 100th Bomb Group offers one of the best places to watch all of the action with sweeping views of the airport runways. David Tallichet, founder of Specialty Restaurants Corporation, served as a B-17 co-pilot for the 100th Bomb Group in World War II. He built the restaurant to honor the 100th Bomb Group, one of the worst casualties in the war, with wall-to-wall memorabilia, replica warcraft displayed throughout the property, and Captain's Tables in the dining room. Also on display are authentic artifacts that also showcases the Tuskegee airmen and Hollywood going to war.

“We are deeply saddened that the 100th Bomb Group will be taking its last flight this year. We looked at every scenario to be able to continue serving our guests, but the current business environment and the pandemic have forced us to have to close our doors. We want to thank our loyal guests, employees and community for their patronage and for sharing countless memories and special events with us,” said John Tallichet, President and CEO of Specialty Restaurants Corporation.
