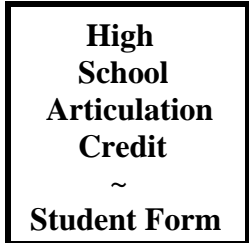

**High School Articulation Agreement
Between**

**Ohio Restaurant Association Education Foundation and Cuyahoga
Community College**



Leading to an Associates Degree at Cuyahoga Community College:
For the purposes of this agreement, an Ohio Restaurant Association Education Foundation student is defined as a student who is enrolled in and successfully completed the high school component of the approved ProStart program.

TO RECEIVE CREDIT THE STUDENT MUST:

1. Student and high school/career center coordinator must sign this form, include a completed Cuyahoga Community College application and submit both forms to the office of Admissions and Records by June 1 of the year of high school graduation.
2. Send an official final high school transcript to Cuyahoga Community College.
3. Provide a final copy of the ProStart Certificate.
4. All certifications and other required materials must be received no later than 24months from posted high school graduation date.
5. Materials must indicate that the student has successfully completed the Ohio Restaurant Association Education Foundation/ProStart program.
6. The student meets the criteria as outlined for each course.
7. Students must be admitted to the College as a degree-seeking student within the Hospitality Management department (Culinary Arts, Lodging/Tourism Management or Restaurant/Foodservice Management majors).

NO CREDIT WILL BE AWARDED UNTIL THE STUDENT MEETS ALL OF THE ABOVE CONDITIONS.
