Andrew Cribbet, Ballet/Modern



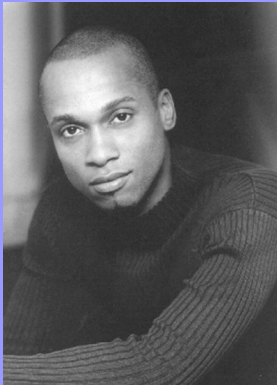
