Day 1, Mon. April 13 (D)

We make our way south today to **Fairview Heights, Ill.** Lodging tonight at the **Drury Inn,** where you'll enjoy a relaxing complimentary 'Happy Hour' & evening meal, giving you the opportunity to get to know your fellow travel mates.

<u>Day 2, Tues. April 14</u> (B, D)

After a hearty breakfast at the hotel, we travel to Paducah, Kentucky, home of the **National Quilt Museum.** This museum, which is recognized by USA Today, as one of the world's top quilt displays, exhibits fiber art & quilting from around the world. Day 3, Wed. April 15 (B, D)

Our trek today takes us to **Chattanooga, Tenn.** We'll climb aboard the **Incline Railway** as it takes us to the top of **Lookout Mountain**. You'll ride in a Trolley-style car that climbs at a 72% grade. Once up there you'll be witness to some of the most incredible views looking down over the Chattanooga Valley. After this thrilling ride we'll then continue our journey south with overnight lodging tonight in **Morrow, Georgia.** (Yes, you guessed it, another 'Happy Hour'!!)

Day 4, Thurs. April 16 (B, D)

This morning our travels take us to **Fort Valley, Ga.** for a visit to **Lane Orchards.** A trip to Georgia Peach Country isn't complete without a visit to a Peach & Pecan Orchard, right? Since 1908 Lane Orchards have been growing Georgia's finest peaches & pecans on their sprawling 11,000 acre orchards. Take home some of the many variety of goods they have to offer, anything from fresh fruit, to pecans, preserves, or homemade treats. And best of all you'll get a chance to try a dish of their famous Peach Ice Cream!!! After lunch there at the orchard we then continue our trek to the **Golden Isles.** After checking into our beachfront hotel, which will be our home for the next 3 nights, we will enjoy a dinner at a local restaurant.

 - ~ Visit to St. Simon's Lighthouse This 1872 lighthouse is still in operation today.
 - ~ The King & Prince Hotel Will hear the role this hotel played as a radar school in WW II.
 - ~ **Drive by of the WW II Museum** Learn about area's extraordinary contributions during WW II.
 - ~ Visit to Christ Church of Frederica ... History dating back to 1736!
 - ~ Dinner at a local favorite, Iguana's. ... Home to some of the best 'Sweet Georgia White Shrimp'
 - ~ Return to our beach-front hotel... (Night #2 of 3)
