## Appalachia 2007

For the past seventeen years a group of SPY teens and adults and has been traveling to Appalachia to help with a home repair program organized by the Catholic Churches of Preston County, West Virginia. This summer was no different as 46 teens and 19 adults from St. Peter's journeyed once again to work camp from July 15<sup>th</sup> through July 20<sup>th</sup>.

Our trip began at the 9:30am mass on Sunday where the congregation joined Father Ray in praying for our group to have a safe and enriching trip. After mass the parking lot behind Sappington Hall looked chaotic as we began squeezing our luggage, tools, food and ourselves into cars, mini-vans and pick-up trucks. It is a 3-4 hour drive to the work camp with a stop for lunch on the way. The work camp itself consists of a large building that houses separate dormitories with bunk beds for the men and women. The basement has a kitchen and dining area. After we arrived, we unloaded and started dinner. After dinner we took some time to learn about the local community, its culture and history and the impact we would have on the people we were helping.

We were divided into six teams; each led by a group of adults, and we were given our work sites. Work at these sites included installation, repair or replacement and painting of roofs, floors, walls, porches, stairs, ramps, windows, doors, painting, bathrooms, plumbing, running water, siding and underpinning. One site even needed an addition added to the existing trailer. During the week, each team took a turn setting up for breakfast & lunch, cooking dinner, dinner cleanup, bathroom detail, or planning the praise and worship service for the evening.

Every day began with a simple breakfast, packing lunch and piling into cars to drive to our work site. At the end of each work day we had time to clean up and relax before dinner. After dinner, in addition to time for praise and worship we also had time for more fellowship through activities such as soccer, football, singing, playing board games, dodge ball or volleyball. Thursday night, after dinner, was spent around a camp fire sharing our reflections on the past week and how it impacted us. During the week, we were the hands and feet of Jesus Christ, assisting families who were in need. It was an eye-opening, lifechanging experience for all of us and gave us a chance to be agents of change in an area filled with poverty.
