# ***SPRING CLEANING IN THE CEMETERY***

Grass cutting season is upon us and we need to clean-up the cemetery from the fall and Christmas decorations. Within the next two weeks, we are requesting that you tidy the graves of your loved ones from personal items and decorations.

Here are the guidelines for cemetery maintenance:

- In order to provide for the safety of the maintenance crew, no silk flowers are permitted on the graves during grass cutting season (April 1 – November 1).
- Shrines, statues, or perpetual lamps are permitted only if they are attached to the base of the headstone. These or any other items may not be placed on the ground near the grave so as to inhibit grass cutting. St. Peter's will not be responsible to damage done to these items if they are not attached to the headstone.
- No permanent plantings or planters are permitted on the gravesite.

## **MONUMENTS:**

- If your loved one was buried a year ago or longer, you are required to purchase a headstone to mark the grave. If this is not accomplished, St. Peter's may install a simple ground marker at the expense of the family. It is important that the graves be properly identified within a timely manner.
- Monument companies are required to notify the cemetery director before marking or installing a monument or ground-level plaque.
