



Proposed Requirement Standards (IEHA Boot Camps) - Accepted - Effective 1/1/2021

Eligibility Details

A SCETT Fund **participant** must submit a completed SCETT Fund application for education benefits 45 days prior to the scheduled Boot Camp to determine eligibility. The applications should be sent to eclegg@scettf.org or faxed to 202-942-2323 as soon as available.

In order to be screened for eligibility the application requirements for each participant are as follows; **legal name, email address, social security number, seniority date (to determine if the Frontline Program will be required before Boot Camp), signature and date.** A newly formatted application will be made available for IEHA Boot Camp participants.

Deadlines

Once the applications are received and screened for eligibility, a spreadsheet will be made available for submission to the IEHA for appropriate invoicing. The spreadsheet will be available no less than 30 days prior to the scheduled Boot Camp.

No changes are to be made 30 days prior to scheduled Boot Camp as we must take into consideration the invoicing process and the participant's requirement to complete the IEHA application as well as the Frontline Program if applicable.
