Learn about Navajo history, culture and heritage from your expert as you travel deeper into the natural wonders of this unique landscape. Spend the rest of the day relaxing at your lakefront resort. ## **DAY 4: 31 AUGUST 2022**

### **Leisurely Lake Powell.**

Travel through Bryce Canyon Country on a portion of the Scenic Highway 89, recognized by National Geographic as the No. 1 Driver's Drive in the world. You will be struck by the beauty of Bryce Canyon National Park, an otherworldly landscape of red rock pillars known as hoodoos, pink cliffs, and endless vistas. (Breakfast / Dinner with Wine)

### **Zion National Park.**
